This term our science topic is 'our bodies', this week's lesson focused on drawing around members of the class, adding details and labelling parts of the body. Our PE topic is 'team building' we have had lots of fun co-operating with partners to complete challenges as well as thinking about the skills we we need in order to work well alongside others.
